At C.A.T.S., 289 students (93%) received on average 2 hours of service per student. This included academic advisement, student success workshops on transition to high school for ninth-graders and match and fit for 10th-graders, and student college visits


C.A.T.S. PARTICIPATION

C.A.T.S students and their families participated in many services informing them about the resources available to help them excel in high school and beyond.

About 57% of CATS ninth- and 10th-grade students received one on one academic advising and counseling where we discussed students' performance in the classroom, college and career planning, and social-emotional support.

A total of 1056 unique students (94%) and 203 families at DRLC received GU4LA services, including workshops, peer mentor training, college visits, tutoring, and dual enrollment support.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

Workshops and counseling/advising were our two standout services offered to students. Workshops provided information about graduation requirements. financial aid, and the four systems of higher education. One-on-one counseling and advising focused on academics including transcript analysis, financial aid, and social-emotional support.
