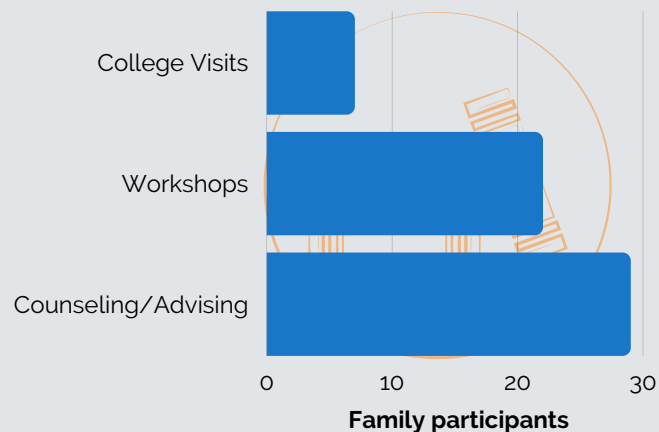


FAMILY PARTICIPATION
