

THE GU4LA IMPACT



AUG. 19, 2021-DEC. 17, 2021




At HPHS, 714 students, or **96%** of the freshman and sophomore classes received GU4LA services over the fall 2021 semester. Services included one-on-one advising, college workshops, increasing students' college knowledge and boosting their leadership skills.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

About **93%** of our students participated in workshops covering topics such as the transition to high school, A-G requirements, credit recovery, and the four systems of higher education. About **86%** of our ninth- and 10th-grade students received advising/counseling on academic, college and career, and social-emotional topics.
