## How It Works

The Intern Project (TIP) will place you in a PAID virtual, on-site, & hybrid, internships based on your skills and career interests paired with a company's unique values and needs.

### Application:

(part 1 is a short essay, part 2 is a quick video), then we make matching recommendations based on your interests and the company's job description(s).

## Programming

Participants will receive virtual trainings to prepare for their internship.

**Workshops include:** email and phone etiquette; office culture; Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion; case studies discussions, and more.

We provide ongoing coaching to ensure the placement is successful. Plus we offer field trips to visit other companies to learn about jobs and network with other professionals.
