

## THE GU4LA IMPACT



## AUG. 19, 2021-DEC. 31, 2021



At Jefferson, 375 unique students, or **94%** of the freshman and sophomore classes, received nearly 3 hours, on average, of GU4LA services. Such services included workshops, dual enrollment, academic advising, financial aid counseling, and college visits. GEAR UP staff helped to increase student college and financial aid knowledge.

### SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

GEAR UP provided 341 ninth- and 10th-graders, or **85%**, counseling and advising services in the fall 2021 semester. This resulted in over **118 hours** of students receiving one-on-one support and guidance to understand their academic transcripts, A-G requirement progress, and CSU and UC eligibility recommendations. Additionally, 41 students received counseling and advising for dual enrollment courses with LACC and LATTC.

### FAMILY ENGAGEMENT



We engaged families in a variety of services, including workshops and college visits, which left them feeling more informed about various postsecondary pathways and how to support their children and plan for success.

### FAMILY PARTICIPATION

The most popular services in the fall semester were workshops on college preparation/financial aid. Eighteen families participated in 56 hours of workshops, which included:

Parents walked away understanding financial aid requirements and how to successfully complete admission requirements (GPA and A-G requirements) for each system.
