We served 289 Libra Academy students, or 85%, and provided an average of 1 hour of service to each student. This included academic advising, college visits, comprehensive peer mentoring, college and career workshops, and financial aid workshops.

Nearly 1,000 unique Marquez students, or 93%, and 316 families at Marquez received GU4LA services. This included academic advising, peer mentoring, financial workshops for families, workshops to strengthen socio-emotional skills, and dual enrollment support.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

In one-on-one and small group academic advising, we reviewed graduation and A-G requirements, tutoring resources, and opportunities to challenge themselves through enrichment or dual enrollment. In our workshops, students learned more about graduation and A-G requirements, the 4 systems of college, financial aid, and socio-emotional skills.
