UNIQUE GU4LA STUDENTS SERVED

HOURS PROVIDED

At Maual Arts, 465 unique students, or **84%** of the freshman and sophomore classes, received GU4LA services. These services included individual and small group academic advising, dual enrollment support, student workshops, BSAP advisory community circles, and peer mentoring.


We provided an average of 30 minutes of individualized counseling to 258 students.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHT

The GEAR UP team spent approximately 30 hours in nine classrooms providing student workshops. For the ninth-grade class, we presented the Three Buckets, which focused on high school graduation requirements. College Match and Fit was the focus of 10th-grade workshops. In this series, students learned about their options for higher education.

HOURS PROVIDED

We provided 225 hours of service to 97 families via workshops such as college match and fit and transition to high school as well as counseling/advising and parent field trips.

FAMILY PARTICIPATION

Following the academic advising sessions we hold with students, our goal is to share what we discussed with their parents.

As a result, we spoke with 50 families for an average of 10 minutes to share their student's progress.

When speaking with parents, we share student grades, high school graduation, college admission requirements, and how GPA affects college admission.

We also love giving parents the opportunity to share what they want us to know about their student so we can provide the best possible support.
