
During the fall semester, we were able to serve and support 864 unique students, or about **78%** of classes of 2024 and 2025. Students participated in workshops, counseling and advising, social-emotional learning, and career awareness opportunities.

#### WORKSHOP HIGHLIGHTS

Our "College Readiness" workshop reviewed college acceptance prerequisites, including minimum GPAs, A-G courses, and extracurriculars. The "3 Buckets" workshop explored high school graduation requirements, including A-G courses, CDE guidelines, and LAUSD supplemental prerequisites. The "Tutor.com" workshop helped our students access free online tutoring to support their academic aspirations.

The GEAR UP team at Monroe High School continues to dedicate time to engaging and supporting families by providing interactive workshops that enhance their knowledge of financial aid, A-G requirements, and social-emotional learning.

#### FAMILY PARTICIPATION

Over 120 families participated in our educational workshops. Two of our highest workshop categories included academic and financial aid. We had our highest turnout – 76 families – in our "3 Buckets" presentation, which informed parents about graduation requirements. Overall, families received 367 hours in parent workshop services.
