

THE GU4LA IMPACT

AUG. 19, 2021-DEC. 17, 2021



During the fall 2021 semester, we were able to serve 568 unique students, or **94%** of the freshman and sophomore classes. Students received GU4LA services, which included workshops that highlighted A-G requirements, graduation requirements, and college and career readiness. We had a high number of students involved in our peer mentor program, college field trips, and other direct services.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

Among our most popular services were counseling and advising. Advising included one-on-one and small group sessions, where we covered topics such as academic, college readiness, career planning, and social-emotional.

Our Community Rep for Roybal Learning Center dedicates her time to engaging our families and informing them about the resources available not only to children but for themselves.

We take families on college tours, hold interactive career workshops, and inform them about the affordability of college through Cash for College workshops.

FAMILY PARTICIPATION

Below are some of the services that received the most participation, with over 350 hours of service provided to 67 families:

- **Counseling and advising**, which included topics covering A-G requirements, credit recovery, enrichment opportunities, tutoring options, and grad checks/4-year plans.
- **Family workshops**, which included virtual and inperson meetings covering topics such as high school graduation requirements transitioning to high school, and financial aid.
