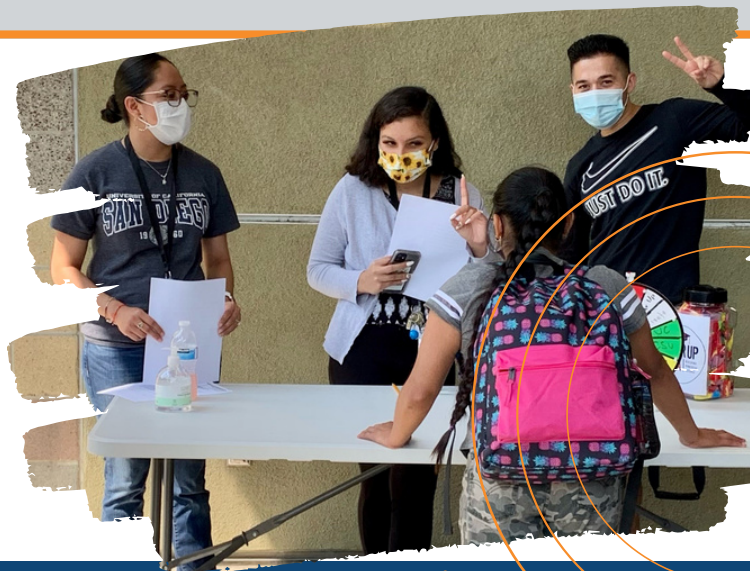

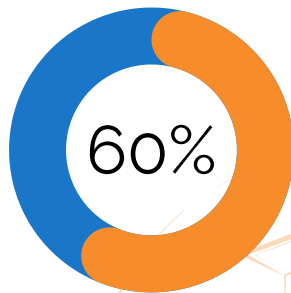

At MCLC, GEAR UP has reached 828 unique students, or **90%** of the freshman and sophomore classes, providing, on average, over two hours of services to each student! The GU team has also provided services to 100 families. Students and families learned about high school requirements, college access information, and what it takes to be a competitive college applicant.

SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

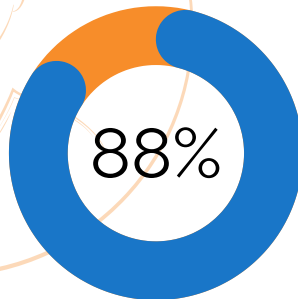
COUNSELING & ADVISING



About 60% of MCLC students (561) had one-on-one counseling sessions with GU staff to discuss their individual progress and focus on their needs. The GU team spent an average of 18 minutes counseling each student.

WORKSHOPS

About 88% of MCLC students (816) participated in workshops with GU staff. The GU team worked with students on graduation and college entrance requirements, as well as the basics of financial aid and how to pay for college.



ALC PARTICIPATION

ALC ninth- and 10th-graders participated in grade-level workshops, including:

- **Three Buckets**, where freshmen learned about graduation requirements, what credits are and how to get them, and why it's important to pass all their classes.
- **Admissable vs. Competitive**, a workshop in which 10th-graders learned what will make them competitive candidates when it's time to apply for college.
