

## AUG. 19, 2021-DEC. 31, 2021




About 968 GEAR UP students at Fremont received, on average, 1.83 hours of GU4LA services during the fall 2021 semester, increasing their college and financial aid knowledge and boosting their leadership skills one service at a time.

### SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

Our most successful service was student workshops, with an **88%** participation rate. Through in-class and pull-out presentations, students received valuable information on high school graduation requirements, the four systems of education, transcript analysis, and self-advocacy. College and career workshops were also instrumental in encouraging students to explore their different pathways options.
